By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Sahara Sands Spring Classic (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

US EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

.AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

ATTENTION COMPETITIORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (US Equestrian (USEF), AHA) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

Exhibitors Entry Check List and Information

COGGINS

All horses exhibited or on the grounds <u>must</u> have had a coggins test within the 12 months prior to the show dates. It is strongly suggested that you have your original results with you in case of inspection. The show office is required to see a copy. To expedite check in please have copies ready when checking in.

ONLY ONE HORSE PER ENTRY FORM

Enter complete name, address, zip code and phone contact number of owner. The owners name on the entry must be the same as on registration papers or a copy of purchase agreement or sales contract must be included.

HORSES

Include copies of registration papers for all horses entered. Horses name must be entered as it appears on the registration papers. Enter all horse information requested on the entry form. Enter the riders name, AHA & USEF numbers, classes to be entered, and total entry fees.

TRAINERS

Enter complete name, address and contact phone number of trainer if other than owner. If there is no trainer then owner must sign again as trainer on back of entry.

FARM MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Include copies of AHA Farm (Business) membership card if horses are registered under a farm name. Include current USEF farm registration certificate (if applicable). In the case of farm ownership or double ownership, one owner must be a member of USEF.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS - RIDER/DRIVER/HANDLER/TRAINER

Include copies of current USEF and AHA "competition" cards for every rider/driver/handler/trainer. In the case of amateur classes, every Rider/Driver/Handler 19 & over or in the case of 18 year olds as of Dec. 1st showing in AT Classes must be amateur certified by USEF or apply in the show office before showing. Exhibitors may apply for a USEF Sr. Membership (\$80) or upgrade their current card to amateur (no fee)

USEF NON-MEMBER

All competitors participating in the role of: rider, driver, handler, vaulter, lunger, owner, lessee and/or agent in AHA qualifying classes must have a current USEF membership, or complete the USEF Show Pass Form online at **www.usef.org/show-pass**. Competitions cannot accept payment for a Show Pass from exhibitors. Non-USEF members are limited from obtaining more than one Show Pass per competition year.

AHA SINGLE EVENT FEE

A single event fee will be charged for every owner/rider/driver/handler/trainer that does not have a current AHA "competition" membership. AHA memberships may be applied for in the show office or on line at arabianhorses.org. In the case of farm ownership the farm must have a current AHA "business" card in the farm name. A "business" card is for ownership only. All riders/drivers/handlers must have individual AHA "competition" cards. AHA requires for results that all names be entered exactly as they appear on the membership card. See Fee table for current Single Event Fee charge.

SIGNATURES ON ENTRY FORM

Make sure all signatures are on the entry blank, including permission for minor to show box. If there is no trainer, then owner must sign again in trainer box. A minor cannot sign the entry form anywhere. A parent or guardian, agent, trainer must sign for a minor in required signature boxes, and then print the name of the minor under adult signature. If the adult is not showing and only signing for minor AHA & USEF memberships are not required. Please include name, address and date of birth for all minors.

PAYMENT

Include check to cover all fees. Open checks will not be accepted for pre entry or to hold stalls. Any open checks received for entry fees will be charged post entry.

CORRECT ENTRIES

<u>It is the exhibitor's responsibility to fill out entries correctly.</u> No packets will be given out until entries are complete. Check the back of your back number to make sure you are entered in correct classes. Please wear correct back number for that horse to avoid incorrect results.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

ADDITIONALLY, AT LEAST ONE SHARPS CONTAINER PER FIFTY OCCUPIED STALLS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF NEEDLES AND OTHER DISPOSABLE SHARP INSTRUMENTS IN CONVENIENT LOCATIONS IN BARNS HOUSING COMPETITION HORSES. IT IS THE COMPETITIONS MANAGEMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REPLACE SUCH CONTAINERS WHEN FULL AND DISPOSE OF THEM PROPERLY. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT MAY FINE ANY INDIVIDUALS INCLUDING TRAINERS, OWNERS, EXHIBITORS OR THEIR AGENTS UP TO \$100.00 FOR IMPROPER DISPOSAL OF NEEDLES OR OTHER SHARP DISPOSABLE INSTRUMENTS.

STATE FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE -

EARLY ARRIVAL: Wednesday, after 4:00 PM. Horses may not enter the barn until Sahara Sands management officially opens the barn. "Early Arrival" charge is listed in the Entry Fees table. See detailed information under "EARLY ARRIVAL" in the Rules and Regulations section

ARRIVAL: Thursday

DEPARTURE: Monday, prior to 10:00 AM.

Exhibitors are cautioned that **absolutely no stabling can be provided before specified arrival time or after specified departure time**. Minnesota State Fair Board contract prohibits modification of these times in any way by the Show Committee.

BARN

All exhibitors are expected to maintain the aisle bordering their stalls in a clean and orderly manner. In accordance with state fire regulations, no autos, truck or trailers will be permitted in the barn. Loading and unloading will be permitted at the curb next to the barn. No parking will be allowed in this area. At no time may any vehicle be parked in front of any barn entrance. After unloading; cars, trucks and trailers must be moved to the designated parking lot west of the Compeer (AgStar) Arena. This means no parking on any black top surface. Vehicles may not be parked on lawns, in driveways, on sidewalks, nor may they park in the streets with the exception of handicapped permit parking. Violators will be ticketed; vehicles will be towed and impounded at owner's expense.

SMOKING

or any other open flame is prohibited in ALL BUILDINGS. Individuals who are found smoking in any State Fair Building will be issued a warning ticket. If they are found smoking a second time, they may be fined and or banned from exhibition with no refunds.

AISLES/DECORATIONS

All drapes must be fire retardant (documentation is required) and they must be retreated whenever cleaned or washed (documented). The tops of all stalls must be uncovered at all times. Electrical appliances such as, but not limited to coffee pots, hot plates, pans, refrigerators etc. are prohibited. These regulations are made and enforced by the Minnesota State Fair Board. The show committee will have no authority to intervene on behalf of exhibitors. Everyone's compliance is requested in this matter.

CAMPING

No overnight tenting or camping will be permitted, except in self-contained camper units. Electric hook ups are available.

CAMPING IS ONLY PERMITTED IN THE SAHARA SANDS DESIGNATED LOT. CAMPING LOT WILL BE ASSIGNED WHEN CAMPING REGISTRATION FORM IS RECEIVED. ANYONE CAMPING IN A LOT OTHER THAN THE DESIGNED LOT WILL BE CHARGED \$250/DAY TO COVER THE COST OF THE ENTIRE LOT.

EXERCISE FACILITIES AND MOVING OF HORSES:

Exhibitors are requested to keep horses within designated areas (barn, coliseum, and exercise areas).

Three arenas are available for use during the course of the show. Not all arenas are available for exercise

- A. The cover all arena adjacent to the coliseum will be open throughout the show beginning Thursday *Cover All arena measures 71' x 120' with Ag lime base with 3" sand footing.
- B. Compeer (AgStar) arena near the horse barn will be available throughout the show beginning Thursday.
- *Compeer (AgStar) arena 80' x 200' with Ag lime base with 3" sand footing.

 C. The Coliseum should be open for schooling according to the following schedule: These times are not guaranteed and may be

subject to change without prior notice. Wednesday – not open for exercise

Thursday - at times to be announced

Friday -6:00am until ½ hour before the morning session begins / After completion of evening session classes until Midnight Saturday -6:00 am until ½ hour before the morning session begins / After completion of evening session classes until Midnight Sunday -6:00am until ½ hour before the morning session begins / Coliseum will not be open after the completion of the show *The above Coliseum exercise schedule is subject to change, without notice.

- *If the entry ramp garage door is down, and/or the entry gate is shut, the Coliseum arena is not open for exercise.
- *Anyone who enters the Coliseum outside of designated open times, or opens the garage door or entry gate without prior permission of State Fair staff or Sahara Sands management, will be subject to a \$250 fine.
- *Coliseum Arena measures 120' x 270' with clay and sand base.

PETS

Pets must be on a leash. No pets are allowed in the coliseum (exception service dogs). Pets will be allowed in the show office. No pets are to be left unattended in the barn overnight.

ALCOHOL

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

FOOD

Food will be available on the grounds during the show.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The SAHARA SANDS SPRING CLASSIC will not be responsible for any loss or injury to exhibitors or horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, whosoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the Association, any member, and Association hired employees or the State Fairgrounds thereof against all claims of injury occasioned by any horses owned or exhibited by him/her or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All horses exhibited in this show will be entirely at the owner's risk. The show committee reserves the right to make such changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interest of the show.

REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS

Purebred Arabian horses to be shown must be registered with the Arabian Horse Registry and/or Canadian Arabian Horse Registry. HA/AA horses must be registered with the AHA in the Half-Arabian and/or Anglo Arabian Registry or have a CPAR permit. Horses must be entered under their full registered name. Registration number, sire and dam, date of birth, must appear on the entry blank. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with the entry form. Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers. In the case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of sale or lease or statement from owner be submitted with the copy of the registration papers. In the case of Amateur Owner Classes the rider/handler/driver must be same as owner or member of the same family. Farm or corporation owner's the rider/driver/handler must be member of same family. No purchase contracts or lease allowed.

EXHIBITORS

All Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Trainers or persons responsible for signing entry form, entered in this show, must have proof of individual memberships to AHA "Competition" or pay a Single Event Fee of \$35.00 per non-member and of USEF "Competing" membership or fill out the USEF Show Pass form online. Adults that are only signing for youth exhibitors and are not participating as Owner/Rider/Driver/Handler/Trainer are exempt from these non-member fees. Farm ownership must have an AHA membership in the farm name. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in the preparation of entry blanks.

STABLING

All horses must be stabled. NO HORSES MAY SHOW OUT OF TRAILER. Permanent box stalls (with gate) and tie stalls (no gate) are available. Stall assignments will be made as entries are received, with priority being given to those parties who have pre-paid for stalls and are patrons or class sponsors. Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors. Absolutely no stalls will be held without payment in full. If due to injury, death or conditions beyond the control of an exhibitor, a horse that has been entered is not brought to the show, the stall rented for this animal shall automatically revert back to the Show Management. Under no circumstances may this stall be retained for use by another exhibitor without prior consent of the Show Manager. Failure to abide by this regulation could result in expulsion from the show and forfeiture of all winnings.

EARLY ARRIVAL

Horses may arrive on Fairgrounds Wednesday after 4:00 PM only if they have prearranged for Early Arrival and paid the Early Arrival Fee (see Fees Table for Early Entry Fee charge). Check with Sahara Sands show management, before unloading horses for stall assignments. Horses cannot enter the barn before 4pm on Wednesday due to MN State Fairgrounds Staff or contractors cleaning, sanitizing and preparing the barn. Sahara Sands Management cannot allow horses into the barn before MN State Fairgrounds Staff officially opens the barn. Any horse that enters the barn before the barn is officially opened by the Minnesota State Fairgrounds and Sahara Sands show management will be subject to a fine by Sahara Sands.

A limited quantity of hay may be available. Shavings will also be available, all at current market price. Each exhibitor must supply their own grain. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding or purchase some from Fairgrounds. Bedding is not included with stalls.

Every horse entered in the show will be assigned an identification number (back number) and it is important for the proper handling of the show that the correct horse number be worn by rider/drivers/handlers. Please check your back numbers to make sure you are entered in the correct classes.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AMATEUR CLASSES

All Riders/Drivers/Handlers 19 & over, or in the case of 18 year olds as of Dec. 1st showing in AT Classes MUST have in their possession an Amateur Card issued by USEF or make application for said card prior to exhibiting. Applications may either be by joining USEF (at current membership price) or upgrading for amateur certification (no fee if have current Card). Handlers/Drivers/Riders 17 & under after Dec. 1st are considered amateur and may obtain a USEF Show Pass if they do not have a current USEF "Competition" card.

If age 18 on Dec 1 your USEF Card will say Senior. This means you may show in any JT Classes (according to AHA Rules), but must be USEF Amateur Certified to show in ATR classes. Should you turn Pro in any other breed you can not show in amateur classes. If age 18 after Dec 1, your USEF Card will say Junior and may show in JT & AT classes and do not need to be USEF amateur certified.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN CLASS

Six (6) or more entries constitute a class. If fewer than six entries are received, the class may be cancelled and exhibitors notified accordingly. The committee reserves the right to split any class with so many entries that all cannot be shown properly or combine like classes for which there are insufficient entries.

POST ENTRIES

Post entry fees will apply on all entries postmarked after midnight on April, 3rd 2024. Entries will be accepted at the stated post entry fee up to the beginning of the session in which the class occurs. Office staff would appreciate entries for the first 5 classes in the beginning of any sections be in at least one half hour before session begins.

DICIPLINE/ABUSE

If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made any false statement in regard to any animal, or article, exhibited or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with any of the judges in the performance of his or her duties, said exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Show management reserves the right to remove any of the above listed from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor which are deemed excessive by a judge, USEF steward or show veterinarian, in the show ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. Such action(s) could include, but not limited to excessive use of whips, spurs or bamboo poles.

OPEN CHECKS

No open checks will be accepted for pre-entry fees or stall reservations. All pre-entries and stall reservations must be accompanied by fully completed negotiable checks dated on or before the date of close of entries. Entries received without such checks will be charged post entry fees and postmark date for stabling priority will be negated.

AGE OF HORSE

The age of a horse shall be reckoned as beginning of January 1st of the year which it was foaled except foals born in the current calendar year.

AGE OF RIDER

The age of a rider shall be determined as of December 1st of each year and shall be maintained until December 1st of the following year.

STALLIONS

Stallions may be shown by ladies or youth in any class except Showmanship at Halter, Walk-Trot and Lead Line. No Half Arabian Stallions 2 years and older may be shown in any halter class. HA/AA Stallions 2 & over may be shown in performance.

CALLS FOR CLASSES

Classes will be called promptly. Last/3rd call will be given when call for the line-up is given for the preceding class. Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse in the class enters the ring. After two minutes have expired, the gate will close and the class will begin. No horses will be allowed to enter the arena once the class has started. In the interest of a fast moving show, the above procedure will be followed at all times.

NO SHOWS

To expedite the flow of classes, scratches must be reported to the show office or gate before the beginning of the class. A No Show Fee will be assessed per class if there is no proof of a scratch or vet out in the exhibitors file or on the gate copy of the class sheet.

PA SYSTEM

Due to possible unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his horse at the gate at the appropriate time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system, no protest will be upheld nor any section changed on the basis of a PA breakdown.

ATTIRE

It is the tradition of the show ring that handlers/riders/drivers be correctly attired for each class that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. The management may, at its discretion, bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

ADMISSION TO ARENA

No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, officials, their assistants and the show photographer. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the judge.

REFUNDS

Refunds of stall rent will be made to any exhibitor who notifies the show secretary they will not be coming, provided such notification is received no later than **April 24th 2024**. No stall refunds after this date. Under special circumstances refunds may be made at the discretion of show management. Refunds of class fees will be made only upon presentation of veterinarian's certificate to the show secretary before last class of the show. Horses at the show must have a veterinarian certificate from the official show veterinarian. Office fees are not refunded.

PRIZE MONEY

No paybacks will be given out in any class.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

All horses earning a 1st or 2nd place in any halter class, including yearlings, will be required to return and show in the appropriate championship class. Exhibitors must come to the show office and enter championship classes.

PRINTING ERRORS

The show committee is not responsible for errors in printing. Corrections will be posted in the Show Office.

SHOEING RULES

Please refer to USEF Rule AR103 Shoeing Regulations

HALTER PROCEDURE

All Breeding/In-Hand classes will be run using Comparative Judging. The Sahara Sands Spring Classic will adhere to the Class Procedure outlined in COMP 815 of the current online AHA Handbook.

PROOF OF VACCINATIONS

Please refer to USEF Rule GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule.

All horses are required to have a current negative coggins (within one year) AND proof of vaccination for Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) within the last 6 months prior to entering the stables.

PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP

Copies of all required AHA and USEF membership cards must be submitted with the entry form. If membership cards are not included with the entry form, the "Look Up" fee may apply.

VERIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP

A "Look Up" fee will be charged per entry that requires the secretary to verify any owner, trainer, or rider/handler information including but not limited to: AHA or USEF membership numbers, membership expiration dates, membership status, Safe Sport completion status, or to check for the existence of a membership online.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Show management has contracted with a professional photography company to provide Official show photography services. Photographs will be taken of exhibitors/horses in each class and made available for purchase on the Official Photographer's website. No other person/company may photograph, sell, or give away images taken anywhere on the show grounds without prior written consent from the Official Photographer. Persons may, however, photograph family members and their own horses. Contact the Official Photographer with any special requests.

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Poicies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org

SCHOOLING CLASSES

All Schooling designated classes are open to all riders. Purebred Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo Arabian horses will show together in the same class. Show attire and tack not required, but riders must wear boots with a heel. Appropriate saddle for the class being shown must be used, however, horses may be shown in training equipment. Horses in "Schooling" classes will be shown at a Walk, Trot/Jog, and Canter/Lope.

TO BE ANNOUNCED (TBA) CLASSES

Contact the show secretary to purchase a TBA class. TBA classes will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. TBA class slots may be restricted to the type of class that can be purchased, please see the show schedule for restricted TBA classes. Sahara Sands retains the right to refuse any TBA class request for any reason, including but not limited to, those that do not fit into the show schedule or is excessively restrictive in those who can participate. Only AHA main ring classes can be purchased as TBA's unless the type restriction states otherwise. Those purchasing TBA classes will be required to pay a TBA Fee (See Fees Table), which includes the class sponsorship and class entry fee. TBA class sponsorships cannot be combined with the sponsorships included in the Patron Sponsorship package. TBA class names and numbers will be posted on the Sahara Sands website as they are filled, and will be posted in the show office during the show. Post entry fees will not be charged for TBA classes entered after the Pre-Entry deadline has passed. Type restricted TBA classes that have not been filled by April 22, 2024 may have the restriction removed at Sahara Sands management's discretion.

BIRTHDAY BASH CLASSES

All Birthday Bash designated classes are open to all riders age 55 or older at the time of the show. Purebred Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo Arabian horses will show together in the same class. Appropriate attire and tack for the class being shown must be used, vintage attire and/or tack is encouraged. Horses in Western, English and Hunter classes will be shown at a Walk, Trot/Jog, and Canter/Lope.


